Plan Harvests to Retain Quality Trees and Limit Residual Damage

- Carefully plan harvests to reduce damage to remaining trees, which can reduce their carbon sequestration rate and storage if decay and rot are introduced
- o Healthy, productive forests are bests for both storage and sequestration

Benefits

- Helps to ensure healthy forest conditions for future sequestration
- Reduce emissions from decay and mortality



Considerations

• Carbon gains are minimal
